Who Should Attend

This qualification is for a variety of candidates, including new employees with minimal or no prior food safety knowledge and individuals handling low risk or wrapped foods including:

- New employees with no prior food safety knowledge of food safety
- Front of house staff such as waiting or checkout staff
- Back of house staff such as kitchen porters or warehouse staff

Learning Outcomes

By the end of this course delegates should be able to:

- Demonstrate an understanding of the risks associated with handling food
- Show an understanding of how to keep themselves clean and hygienic
- Show an understanding of the importance of cleaning in catering premises
- Show an understanding of how to keep the product safe

Course Content

Delegates will receive training in the following subjects:

- Food Safety (food hygiene, hazards, responsibilities)
- Personal Hygiene
- Cleaning
- Contamination

Course Duration

The course is ½ day in duration (3 hours + exam)

Assessment Method & Certification

The assessment will be by the completion of a multiple choice question examination at the end of the course. On successful completion of the course, delegates will receive a certificate of competence, which is valid for 3 years.

Candidates wishing to obtain a Nationally Accredited Certificate would sit the exam for the relevant Awarding Body (for the additional price of the certification and exam fee of the Awarding Body).
