This qualification encourages a flexible approach to training delivery that takes account of learners' needs and preferences. It covers initial assessment, planning and preparation, training delivery, assessment and evaluation. The qualification provides an opportunity to understand and practice a professional approach to training design and delivery, with a structured syllabus and assessment opportunity. This qualification replaces the CIEH Level 3 Award in Training Skills and Practice (TSP).

Who Should Attend

This qualification is essential for anyone wishing to become a CIEH registered trainer. It is ideal for anyone who needs to understand the basics of training practice, presentation skills or wants to refine their training techniques. This is the benchmark trainer skills qualification for CIEH registered trainers delivering training that is not publicly funded. (Please see EAT for Public Sector /Funded training delivery requirements).

- Understand inclusive teaching and learning approaches in education and training.
- Understand ways to create an inclusive teaching and learning environment.
- Be able to plan inclusive teaching and learning.
- Be able to deliver inclusive teaching and learning.
- Be able to evaluate the delivery of inclusive teaching and learning.

Course Content

The CIEH Level 3 Award in Training – Principles and practice is based on one QCF unit from the CIEH Level 3 Award in Education and Training.

The CIEH Level 3 Award in Training – Principles and practice covers the following topics:

- Inclusive teaching and learning approaches in education and training
- Ways to create an inclusive teaching and learning environment,
- Planning inclusive teaching and learning,
- Delivering inclusive teaching and learning,
- Evaluating the delivery of inclusive teaching and learning.

Course Duration

The course is normally 3 days in duration (can be extended to 4days for large groups)

Assessment Method & Certification

The assessment will be by the completion of an observed presentation on the last day of the course and a short written assignment (1,000 words).

On successful completion of the course, delegates will receive a certificate of competence.

Candidates wishing to obtain a Nationally Accredited Certificate would sit the exam for the relevant Awarding Body (for the additional price of the certification and exam fee of the Awarding Body).
